

EXPERIENCED MANUFACTURING EXECUTIVE NAMED EFCO PRESIDENT; STEVEN WESTFALL TO START JAN. 8, 2018

MONETT (December 4, 2017) - Steven E. Westfall has been named president of EFCO, effective Monday, Jan. 8, 2018.

"Steve has extensive leadership experience in manufacturing businesses, having achieved topline growth and improved bottom-line results, in part by employing lean manufacturing tools and processes," said Joseph F. Puishys, chief executive of Apogee, EFCO's parent company.

Westfall comes to EFCO from Tuthill Vacuum & Blower in Springfield, MO, where he has been president since 2013. He was instrumental in leading the transformation of the 125-year-old, family-owned industrial manufacturing business. From 2008 to 2013, Westfall led two companies owned by private equity firms – CST Storage and Detroit Tool Metal Products. He gained his leadership experience at EaglePicher Technologies, a \$200 million plus high technology organization with 800 employees that produces batteries for mission critical aerospace, defense and medical markets. At EaglePicher from 1993 to 2008, Westfall held several positions of increasing responsibility; he served as CEO and president from 2005 to 2008, significantly growing revenues and earnings while improving on-time delivery to customers and optimizing manufacturing costs.

He holds an MBA and BS degree from Pittsburg State University in Kansas. The Joplin, MO, native plans to relocate his family to Southwest Missouri.
